Bruce Perron noted that the residents of the Fire Districts will want to know what the costs are going to be to merge before moving forward. Chief Authier and Captain Schenker spoke about getting accurate numbers from District 2 on how many ambulance calls they get monthly/annually. Kevin Taugher discussed the impact the merger could have on residents and also agreed that knowing what the costs were to merge the Districts is what residents need to know before moving forward. Mike Wozniak stated that a member of District 2 Prudential Committee was supposed to attend the meeting but was not present. Mr. Wozniak also said District 2 had also looked at the 6 Merger options and rejected all 6 options. Both Boards agreed to table the Merger discussion till District 2 was willing to participate and we could get a cost estimate.
