T&B working on specs to have additional power back up in the future in case of extended power loss in the future. Probably looking at an RFP

Kevin Taugher asked if we could get an estimate from T&B on the spec estimate by June 2012

Chief explained that the purchase of new pagers and radios for operation of the ambulance and fire was underway; Kevin Taugher requested an account breakout for expenditures

Chief said he was using a company from Chicopee to help assess the needs for new pagers and radios; the dept has used them in the past.

The Ladder truck passed state inspection in May; however a more in depth inspection a few weeks later by 5star found that the brakes needed to be done at a cost of about 5k.

TSM- inspected the ladder and found some deficiencies in the equipment. Costs at the time were unknown at time of meeting. The truck can still be used, it just won't be certified.

Kevin Taugher had questions about the budget from a P/S standpoint, Chief reference the October storm as well as mutual aide to Brimfield and Holyoke as putting the most pressure on the overtime budget.
