Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of Fire District No. 1, in the Town of South Hadley, qualified to vote in the Special Meeting to reconsider Article 5 of the Annual Meeting that was adjourned on April 27, 2023, to meet at:

**Pioneer Valley Performing Arts Charter Public School, 15 Mulligan Drive, South Hadley, MA  
on Wednesday, May, 17, 2023, at 6:00 P.M.,**

To vote on the following article:

**ARTICLE 1** To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, the sum of \$1,760,253 and transfer the sum of \$839,378 from the Ambulance Reserve Fund, and transfer the sum of \$100,000 from Free Cash, and transfer the sum of \$17,908 from Local Receipts for a total of \$2,717,539 to fund the Personnel Services account as detailed in the Prudential Committee FY24 budget document.

HEREOF FAIL NOT and make due return of the warrant with your doings thereon to the District on or before the time of holding said meeting.

Given under our hands this ninth day of May in the year of Our Lord, Two Thousand Twenty-Three.


